The evangelism crisis in North America:

Only 1% of churches have an ongoing evangelism emphasis.



How can your church grow by 10% to 20% if you are a typical-sized congregation?



Megachurch: 2,000 in average weekly attendance

- 1990 300 megachurches
- 2000 600 megachurches
- 2010 1600 megachurches
- 2020 1700 megachurches

Today – unknown but likely around 1,000 megachurches



The rise of the neighborhood church:


- 1. The reality of real estate
- 2. The feel of the room
- 3. Financial sustainability
- 4. Growing bi-vocational and co-vocational ministry
- 5. Diminishing stigma of small
- 6. A return to local preferences
- 7. More targeted ministry
- 8. The drive isn't worth it anymore



The stages of cultural change needed to lead a church toward ongoing evangelism:

From apathy to hospitality
From hospitality to inviting
From inviting to sharing
From sharing to sending





No evangelism. Churches recognize evangelism is a problem but are not doing anything about it.




Horizontal growth methods are replacing vertical growth methods.

Vertical growth: Numerical growth in the same place and time. (e.g., 11:00 a.m. service)

Horizontal growth: Numerical growth by adding different times, venues, and campuses.

Younger generations are not moving as much as in the past.

1940: One in five people moved annually

2020: Less than one in ten people moved annually



Four ways to get shift the culture from apathy to expectation of growth

Celebrate the bright spots in your worship services
Include ways to put boots on the ground in your missions budget
Hold staff and other leaders accountable for gospel conversations
Resource ministries focused on the youngest generations

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The four main ways your church grows numerically

- 1. Conversion growth
- 2. Transfer growth (existing residents at another church)
- 3. Biological growth
- 4. Demographic growth (new residents looking for a church)



Why is my church not growing?

For every 100 in attendance in your church, you will lose each year:

to death
to moving
to transfer to another church in the community
to declining attendance frequency



1. Make a splash with greater hospitality and first impressions ministry.



2. Get the attention of the neighborhood.

How? Neighbor bags and putting something tangible into the hands of your people.



3. Prepare for a surge of opportunities with church fostering & church adoption.

The dropping median church size is a *concern*.

Weekly Attendees in 2000: 137 Weekly Attendees in 2020: 65 The rising median age of a pastor is a *crisis*.

Pastor median age in 1992: 44 Pastor median age in 2017: 54 Pastor median age today: 57



4. A messy group is better than no group. New member classes are a must.
